

THE ENCHANTED DRAWING

The origins of animated film can be glimpsed here. J. Stuart Blackton, then a cartoonist for the New York Evening World, draws in Edison's New Jersey "Black Maria" studio, performing a vaudeville routine known as the "lightning sketch," supplemented by stop-camera tricks that bring the drawn objects to life.



DISCOVERIES ON THE FOREST FLOOR 1-3




BEGONE DULL CARE

(1949) 7 min.

Norman McLaren & Evelyn Lambart

A perfect dance of direct animation of painted colors and shapes with jazz by the Oscar Peterson Trio. "The recorded music was measured on the same clear celluloid strip of film used to draw the images. By using an oscilloscope, McLaren and Lambart could see the vibrations and mark them on clear film." - Heather Pinson



FREE RADICALS

(1958) 5 min.

Len Lye

"I made Free Radicals from 16mm black film leader. I took a graver, various kinds of needles. You stick down the sides with scotch tape and get to work with scratching... You can carry a pictographic design in your head and make a little design. You can't see what you're doing because your hand is in the way. That's why those things have that kind of spastic look." - Len Lye







MOTHLIGHT

(1963) 3 min.

Stan Brakhage

"Mothlight was created by painstakingly collaging bits and pieces of organic matter moth wings, most notably, as well as flowers, seeds, leaves, and blades of grass—and sandwiching them between two layers of clear 16-mm Mylar editing tape." - J. Hoberman This film is silent.



PRUEBA

(2017) 1 min.

Rosario Sotelo

"A cameraless film made with my dental impressions." - Rosario Sotelo



SIX LOOP PAINTINGS

(1970) 11 min.

Barry Spinello

"Sound and image are hand applied directly on to 16mm clear leader. The image at a given instant is repeated both on the image track and soundtrack, so that the viewer is visualizing the image he is hearing. The images and sounds are not painted; they are made by cutting to size and pasting acetate selfadhesive patterns directly onto the clear film... The finer the pattern, the higher pitched the tone. The further spaced the pattern, the deeper the tone I especially recommend Six Loop-Paintings to those interested in the texture of sound and image, and in the ways sound and image can relate to each other." -Barry Spinello



1-2:00PM FILMS BY KIDS

Highlights of short films submitted by kids from the community along withhighlights from thirty years of children's animation workshops across the country, from Vermont to Massachusetts to California.

Yellow Ball Workshop was founded in 1960 in Everett, Massachusetts by animator Yvonne Andersen. Students would learn every aspect of making a film from start to finish. Filmmaker-In-Residence and animator David Ehrlich taught children's animation workshops in Vermont and at the Pacific Film Archive in Berkeley in the 1980s.

Topcraft's core members eventually went on to form Studio Ghibli.
